Your application will be considered by the Competitions and Standards Committee with a view to configuring the best possible structuring of competition. Schools eliminated early in the senior cup will play off each other in the O'Brien Cup. Schools eliminated later along an intermediate point will play each other in the Mungret Cup and those still continuing go ahead to the Senior Cup proper. This coming year, the early rounds of the senior cup will consist of a number of area leagues that begin in October. The placings on these will determine further participation in the Mungret and Senior Cups.

The above listed competitions do not limit other approved competitions taking place to meet the needs of schools, e.g. a local competition, an area league or whatever. These can be suggested and will be submitted to the Competitions and Standards Committee for approval. Schools previously involved in the Development Leagues must assess their fixture schedules in the light of the cups starting in November and the need for improved development.

All competitions have a date of birth cut off point of 1<sup>st</sup> July: e.g. U. 18 next season is U. 18 as at 1<sup>st</sup> July 2006  
There is a provision for category B, C and associate schools to avail of a three month derogation going back to 1<sup>st</sup> April  
This applies to only three players per panel per game.. The players may change from match to match but only up to three players in any one game may avail of it.
